Kenya November 2007

a backpacking alternative to safaris.

Introduction.

Not having the money, or wish, to join an organised safari, I spent 8-24 November backpacking and birding through central Kenya, not visiting any of the famous national parks. My inspiration to do the trip came from a few excellent trip-reports on the net at <u>travellingbirder.com</u>, mainly Michiel de Boer (1996) and Samuel Hansson (2004), which provided me with a rough itinerary and some very good, and mostly, up-to-date maps of the sites.

The rains in the previous months had been of El Niño-like dimensions, which had caused some of the lakes in the Rift Valley to rise by more than a meter. This had flooded lowlying areas at Lake Naivasha, creating good wader-habitat, whereas the flooding at Lake Baringo had brought the shoreline up behind the gallery-forest, meaning that the lake could not be viewed from the shore. In Isiolo everything was lush and green, and far removed from the drought-stricken and dusty place mentioned by birders visiting in 2006 and early 2007.

During my time there I had very pleasant weather, with daytime temperatures of 25 C, long overcast periods and only the occasional shover, though slightly cooler in the highlands at Nyahururu

Logistics.

Travelling between sites involved a number of bus- and matatu-rides, which tended to be hasselfree and cheap, though a few waits of an hour or more were experienced, when changing matatus. Travelling alone made it easier to find space for my backpack, but otherwise an extra seat could be bought for the luggage. Not entering any of the national parks meant, that it was possible to bird on foot at all sites, and distances between accommodation and birding sites were rather small.

I used The Rough Guide to Kenya to find accommodation, usually settling for budget places, as I only used them for sleeping and shovering anyway. Moscito-nets were provided in even the cheapest hostel, as well as a towel, and dinner could be ordered in advance at most places or taken at small local eating places. For eating during the day I brought snacks like bisquits and fruits along, and as the weather wasn't too hot, one litre of mineral water was usually enough, to get me through the day.

Going on public transport and staying at small hostels/hotels meant that I was able to get by on roughly 15 euros/day.

Itinerary.

8.11: landed in Nairobi mid-afternoon, and took a matatu to Naivasha (1.5 hours), where I arrived around 5.30 pm.

- 9.11: startet out at sunrise (6 am) and spent the rest of the day birding the area between the main road and the lakeside at Hippo Point a few km south of town, and also the cliff below the southern suburbs.
- 10.11: took a matatu first thing, to the southern end of Lake Naivasha at Fisherman's Camp, and birded the hillside to the south above the camp until 11 am. The afternoon was spent just outside Naivasha, along the 'Greenhouse Road' (see Hansson 2004) down towards the lakeside.
- 11.11: early morning along 'Greenhouse Road' down to Lake Naivasha, before cathing a bus to Nakuru (1.5 hours), from where another bus took me to Marigat (2 hours). From here it was another hour in the back of a pick-up truck to Kampi ya Samaki on the shores of Lake Baringo, arriving late afternoon. Birded a few hours before sunset north of town.
- 12.11: headed out before sunrise, to reach the cliffs some 4 km west of the lake early in the day, and birded around here until early afternoon. Late afternoon saw me birding between town and Robert's Camp.

- 13.11: once more did the area around the cliffs from sunrise until mid-day, and later on I searched the area around the airstrip.
- 14.11: most of the day was spent travelling in matatus, Kampi ya Samaki Marigat Kabernet Eldoret Kakamega (town) Shinyalu, and from there a bodaboda (bicycle) took me the last few km's to Isecheno in the Kakamega forest. With a couple of hours of daylight left, I did the pump-house trail before it got dark. Arranged for a guide to accompany me the next two days.
- 15.11: sunrise around 6.30 am, and startet out in the clearing around the Rest House, before venturing into the forest in the back. Afternoon was spent along pump-house trail and the Forest Road.
- 16.11: in the morning walked along Forest Road to a few km beyond Rondo Resort, and in the afternoon once around Pump-house trail and Forest Road.
- 17.11: a couple of hours was spent in the morning along Forest Road, before another stint of travelling. Went back through Shinyalu, Kakamega and Eldoret, from where I took a matatu to Nakuru and on to Nyahururu, where I arrived after sunset.
- 18.11: followed the main road past Thompson's Falls, and across the bridge. From there I headed uphill into the forest, where I worked several different paths and cattle-tracks. Afterwards I spent some time around the lake south of the main road, and a brief visit to the falls (rather touristy).
- 19.11: in the morning I went out to the lake above the falls for a few hours, before travelling on to Nanyuki, and from there to Isiolo, where I arrived mid-afternoon. The last few hours of daylight was spent birding the wastewater ponds a few km north of town (Isiolo N).

20.11: at sunrise I walked south along the main road to Nanyuki, exploring different trails leading off the road. Approx. 5 km south of Isiolo a larger dirt road led eastwards (left) at a souvenir stall, and this road was followed for a few km (Isiolo S).

- 21.11: this morning I went westwards towards the low hills, and after crossing two streams reached good bush-country (Isiolo W).
- 22.11: took an early morning bus from Isiolo reaching Nairobi around noon, and from here a matatu took me to Athi River, about an hours drive eastwards along the Mombasa highway. Late afternoon spent exploring around the southern end of town.
- 23.11: followed the rail tracks out of town, to find the extensive area of savanna east of Athi River. Walked further east to a small rocky stream, and birded around here and further south.

24.11: dense fog in the morning, when I tried birding south along the Athi River, in rather disturbed habitat. At noon I took matatu (special hire) to the airport to fly back, which worked out cheaper and much faster, than going all the way back into Nairobi.

Grey Heron (Aredea cinerea) Lake Naivasha 5, Nyahururu 2, Isiolo (N) 1.

Black-headed Heron (*Ardea melanocephala*) Lake Naivasha 5, Isiolo (N) 1, Isiolo (S) 5, Isiolo (W) 2, Athi River 5 – often feeding in fields far from water.

Hamerkop (Scopus umbretta) Lake Naivasha 2, Lake Baringo 1, Isiolo (S) 1, Isiolo (W) 3, Athi River 2.

White Stork (Ciconia ciconia) Lake Naivasha 2, Athi River 2.

Yellow-billed Stork (*Mycteria ibis*) Lake Naivasha 30.

Marabu Stork (*Leptoptilos crumeniferus*) Isiolo (N) 3, Isiolo (W) 2, Athi River 55+ (51 in one flock) – also common in Nairobi, and seen in many towns.

Sacred Ibis (*Threskiornis aethiopicus*) Lake Naivasha 15, Lake Baringo 2, Nyahururu 10, Isiolo 50+ (night-roost in town), Isiolo (S) 5, Isiolo (W) 6, Athi River 10.

Hadada Ibis (*Bostrychia hagedash*) Lake Naivasha 15, Lake Naivasha, Fisherman's camp 6, Nyahururu 15+, Isiolo (S) 1, Isiolo (W) 2, Athi River 2 – common and noisy.

Glossy Ibis (Plegadis falcinellus) Lake Naivasha 1, Nyahururu 26 overflying.

African Spoonbill (*Platalea alba*) Lake Naivasha 30, Lake Baringo 2 migrating., Nyahururu 1.

Egyptian Goose (Alopochen aegyptiacus) Lake Naivasha 25, Nyahururu 2, Isiolo (N) 1, Athi River 3.

White-faced Whistling-Duck (Dendrocygna viduata) Lake Naivasha 20.

Fulvous Whistling-Duck (Dendrocygna bicolour) Lake Naivasha 4.

Maccoa Duck (Oxyura maccoa) Nyahururu 2 at the sewage ponds.

Redbilled Teal (Anas erythrorhyncha) Lake Naivasha 50, Nyahururu 15.

Hottentot Teal (Anas hottentota) Lake Naivasha 6, Nyahururu 25.

Yellow-billed Duck (Anas undulate) Lake Naivasha 5, Nyahururu 10, Athi River 6.

African Black Duck (*Anas sparsa*) Nyahururu 1 female with 6 pull., first seen in the stream and then in the small pond.

Southern Pochard (Netta erythrophthalma) Lake Naivasha 2, Nyahururu 1.

Yellow-billed Kite (*Milvus* (*migrans*) *parasiticus*) Lake Naivasha 1, Kakamega Forest (Shinyalu) 5, Nyahururu 5, Isiolo (N) 1, Isiolo (S) 3, Isiolo (W) 3, Athi River1 – also seen in many towns.

Black-shouldered Kite (*Elanus caeruleus*) Lake Naivasha, Fisherman's camp 1, Lake Naivasha 1, Athi River 4.

Secretary Bird (Sagittarius serpentarius) Athi River 1.

African Fish Eagle (*Haliaeetus vocifer*) Lake Naivasha 2, Lake Naivasha, Fisherman's camp + (heard), Lake Baringo 2, Athi River 1.

Osprey (*Pandion haliaetus*) Lake Naivasha 2-3.

African White-backed Vulture (*Gyps africanus*) Athi River 10.

Rüppell's Griffon Vulture (*Gyps rueppellii*) Athi River 2-3.

African Marsh Harrier (Circus ranivorus) Nyahururu (Thompson Falls) 1 imm.

Eurasian Marsh Harrier (Circus aeruginosus) Lake Naivasha 4.

Pallid Harrier (*Circus macrourus*) Lake Naivasha 2-3 male and 1 female, Nakuru 1 male, Nyahururu 1 male and 1 female, Athi River 1 male.

Eastern Chanting-Goshawk (Melierax poliopterus) Isiolo (S) 1, Athi River 1.

Dark Chanting-Goshawk (Melierax metabates) Lake Baringo 1.

Shikra (Accipiter badius) Lake Baringo 2 ad + 1 juv, Isiolo (W) 1 ad.

Great Sparrowhawk (Accipiter melanoleucus) Kakamega Forest 1.

African Cuckoo-Hawk (Aviceda cuculoides) Nyahururu (Thompson Falls) 2 (pair) sunning themselves in the morning.

European Honey-Buzzard (Pernis apivorus) Lake Naivasha 1.

Augur Buzzard (Buteo augur) Lake Naivasha 4, Lake Naivasha, Fisherman's camp 2 (1 dark), Isiolo (W) 1.

Mountain Buzzard (Buteo oreophilus) Nyahururu (Thompson Falls) 1.

Common (Steppe) Buzzard (Buteo (buteo) vulpinus) Lake Naivasha 2, Kakamega Forest 1, Nyahururu 1.
