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Nærværende rapport vil primært indeholde artslistes for iagttagne fugle og pattedyr samt rejserute, idet der forefindes megen litteratur omhandlende lokaliteter, fugle og pattedyr. Desuden er Australien et vel kortlagt kontinent og der er ingen problemer med opdaterede landkort.

Idet vi begge havde mulighed for en længere tur, valgte vi at gå efter lidt af det meste. Det eneste som på forhånd var besluttet nedprioriteret var havfugledimensionen. Simpelthen fordi det ikke var årstiden til at satse på havfugle. Det skal dertil siges, at vi en del gange brugte tid på at komme frem til havfuglespots, men blev flere gange spillet ud pga. ufarbare veje.

Vi havde besluttet at starte i Perth, Western Australia og returnere fra Darwin, Northern Territory.

Rejseruten i Australien var løst planlagt hjemmefra: Western Australia, Victoria, New South Wales, Queensland og Northern Territory. Tasmania blev besluttet ved ankomst til Melbourne - da vi ikke kunne se Caroline spille en Grand Slam finale *on location*, idet hun jo tabte semifinalen.

Vi valgte at kunne rejse fleksibelt, hvorfor vi havde det nødvendige gear med. Ved hver ankomst til en lufthavn blev der lejet bil og langt de fleste overnatninger blev foretaget i telt i nationalparker eller på officielle campingpladser. Overvægt af overnatning i motel/cabin med aircon☺ skete i Queensland og Northern Territory – ofte fordi campingarealerne var oversvømmede. Maden lavede vi selv og vi foretog indløb lokalt. Dog var besøg på McDonald's ikke helt sjældne – de har fri WiFi.

En del af de områder vi besøgte var plaget af megen oversvømmelse. Dette drejede sig specielt om de indre dele af Victoria, New South Wales og Northern Territory. Dette bevirkede en del ikke uvæsentlige omveje og lokaliteter vi ikke kunne komme ud i.



Transport

Under rejsen fløj vi 3 gange indenrigs. Perth - Melbourne, Brisbane - Cairns og Cairns - Alice Springs. Den oprindelige tanke var at flyve fra Cairns til Darwin, men vi blev anbefalet at besøge Alice Springs. Desuden ville vi køre til Cairns, men da østkysten var ramt af store oversvømmelser og havde modtaget en kraftig tyfon, valgte vi at flyve hen over de værst ramte områder.

I perioden kørte vi samlet 12.390 km. via leje af 2 stk. Nissan Tiida, 3 stk. Toyota Corolla og 1 Toyota RAV4 (i Cairns, da der var særdeles vådt!).

Bilerne var alle af en ganske flot standard og havde kun kørt omkring 10-15.000 km, da vi fik dem. Alle med automatgear, hvilket er en fordel ved venstrekørsel. De 2 stk. som vi lejede i Alice Springs, var dog af dårligere standard og byen har den dyreste billeje og biler uden automatgear!

Begge lokalitetsguides er over 10 år gamle og flere "sikre" lokaliteter for bla. Tropicbirds viste sig at være forældede og bøgerne mangler væsentlig opdatering. Dog gav de god inspiration og i mange tilfælde var de gode nok.

Australien havde ændret sig lidt de senere år, idet tørke er ændret til megen regn. Dette var specielt gældende i det indre Australien. Feks. var områderne omkring Alice Springs helt grønne og der var en hel del oversvømmelse. På én nat, da vi lå i telt ved Ellery Creek, faldt der 90 mm regn og vejen ud af området var oversvømmet den følgende dag, men vi havde Slørugle to aftener i træk!

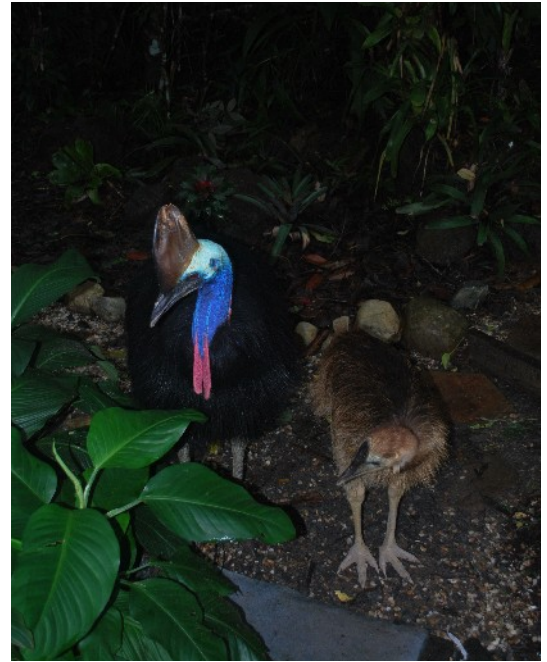
