NEW ZEALAND AND SUBANTARCTIC ISLANDS 3. NOV – 15. DEC. 2009

It has always been my great wish to see the seabirds of the Antarctic Oceans but prices has always kept me far away from these areas. In 2009 I decided, it must be now or never. I was going a different place but saw Polarquest from Sweden advertise in DOF for a 12 days seatrip to the Subantarctic Islands south of New Zealand for about 32.000 danish kroner. That was the absolutely cheapest price. On top came the return airfare to New Zealand. I decided to go and also to see the birds of New Zealand before, as I was never there. I bought a ticket with Cathay Pacific Airways for 9.100 kroner and travelled Copenhagen – London – Hongkong – Auckland.

New Zealand is a very easy country to travel. It is best done by your own or rented car. But I went on public transport, mostly busses. There is a good network of busses although prices are quite expensive, if you don't order ticket online sometime before travelling. New Zealand is full of tourists from everywhere in the world, so getting hotels or hostels can be difficult at places in the southern summer. But it is easy to order rooms online. As I travelled with public transport, there were places I could not reach without big problems. So I missed a few endemic birds. But anyway you never see all the birds in a country. You will have to get used to not seeing a lot of different species. Also that a lot of the common species are the same as you see in Denmark. I walked 4 hours in a valley near Arthur's Pass and saw only one bird, a Dunnock. The weather in New Zealand was mostly good, but it was a cold summer and a strong wind in the whole periode. A few days were spoilt by rain. At sea the wind was strong. To watch the birds with binoculars and scopes were a problem. I was seasick in periodes. On the islands it was no problem and the the trip as a whole was a great experience.

3/11 – 5/11 Travelling. Arriving Auckland, New Zealand.

6/11 and 7/11. Two days visit to the island Tiritiri Matangi. A famous birdisland, where all predators are whiped out and where some of the rarest birds in New Zealand are being introdused to survive. It is possible to stay the night, but there are only few beds. I tried to book one month ahead, but it was already too late. So I missed Little Spotted Kiwi. I took the ferry from central Auckland.

- 8/11. Bus from Auckland to Thames. You get off the bus in the village of Waitakaruru before Thames. Then it is a 10 km walk to Miranda, a famous shorebird destination. There is a nice hostel for birdwatchers.
- 9/11. Miranda most of the day. Many other birdwatchers there. Met some from England. They asked, if I would join them in a pelagic boattrip next day, which I accepted. Driving to Whitianga on Coromandel Peninsula.

- 10/11. Pelagic boattrip from Whitianga at Mercury Bay and the sea. Cost about 900 kroner each for 5 persons. It was worth every krone. We came very close to the seabirds. Very recommended. You see some different species than from Kaikoura on the south island.
- 11/11. Bus from Whitianga to Thames and from there another bus to Lake Rotorua. Lots of tourists and easy to get room.
- 12/11. All day at Lake Rotorua. Good walking along the lake.
- 13/11. Bus from Lake Rotorua to Wellington. Took most of the day. Next day I wanted to stay in Wellington, but there was no room available in the whole town. A footballgame in the world championship was to be played.
- 14/11. Had to go one day earlier with the ferry to Picton on the South Island as no room was available in Wellington. It is possible to see some seabirds from the ferry, but mostly they are not close to the ship. The sailing in Queen Charlotte Sound is extreemely beautiful.
- 15/11. All day birdwatching in the forests close to Picton. Not a good place for birds.
- 16/11. Bus from Picton to Christchurch.
- 17/11 Bus from Christchurch to Arthurs Pass. Birdwatching there all afternoon.
- 18/11. All day birdwatching around Arthurs Pass. I had to book online at the hostel before staying there. It quickly fills up.
- 19/11. Bus from Arthurs Pass to Greymouth. Afternoon birdwatching at the river and the seashore.
- 20/11 Bus from Greymouth to Haast. Rain all day.
- 21/11. Birdwatching around Haast. Especially walk to and from Haast Beach. Heavy rain all day. One of the most rainful places in the world. 6 meter per year.
- 22/2. Bus Haast Queenstown.
- 23/11. Bus Queenstown Te Anau.
- 24/11 -26/11. Birdwatching in forests and mountains near Te Anau. One of the days tour with bus and boat at Doubtful Sound. Cost 1000 kroner. Saw nothing due to rain and fog. Waist of money.
- 27/11. Bus Te Anau Invercargil.
- 28/11 Bus Invercargill Bluff. Ferry Bluff Oban, Stewart Island.
- 29/11 30/11. Walks around Oban and a visit to Ulva Island.
- 1/12. Ferry Oban Bluff. Bus to Invercargil and bus to Dunedin.

- 2/12. All day in Dunedin. Check in at tourhotel with Polarquest. Meeting with all the participants going on the tour to the Subantarctic Islands. Mostly people from Sweeden but also 3 other from Denmark.
- 3/12. Leaving Dunedin through Otago Sound and spending the day at sea.
- 4/12. Snares Island. Landing is not permitted. Most birds seen from small boats. Afternoon and night at sea.
- 5/12 6/12. Auckland Islands. First day spent on Enderby Island and the next on the main island.
- 7/12. All day at sea.
- 8/12 9/12. Macquarie Island. Landing several places.
- 10/12. All day at sea.
- 11/12 12/12. Campbell Island. Several landings with small boats.
- 13/12. At sea and arriving Bluff in the afternoon. Bus to Invercargill and flight to Auckland.
- 14/12 and 15/12. Shoppingday and flight back to Denmark.
